In an effort to keep clinic doors open during provider shortages in rural and frontier South Dakota, Horizon has relied heavily on telehealth over the past two years. Recruitment of primary care providers and dentists is an ongoing challenge for Horizon especially in frontier South Dakota communities. This splash session highlights Horizon's efforts in combatting the workforce shortage using telehealth technologies.
