# ORIGINATING SITES (all facility fee eligible):

- Offices of physicians (02, 03), psychologists, social workers, behavioral health providers, habilitation services providers, and advanced registered nurse practitioners (ARNPs)
- Hospitals & CAHs
- CMHCs
- FQHCs/RHCs
- AEAs/LEAs (school-based clinics)

- Physicians

- Nurse-midwives
- Behavioral health providers (social workers, marital and family therapists, mental health counselors, certified alcohol and drug counselors)
