## **MEDICAID PROVIDERS**

### **ORIGINATING SITES:**

The originating site is any site where the patient is located at the time of service

> MHCP does not pay an originating site facility fee.

**NON-COVERED SERVICES:** Prescription renewals, appointment scheduling, clarification of issues from a previous visit, reporting test results, non-clinical communication, day treatment, partial hospitalization programs, residential treatment services, case management face-to-face contact

- Physician or PA
- NP, CNS, or Nurse midwife
- Public health nurse/org
- RD/nutrition professional
- Audiologist
- Dentist/hygienist/ therapist
- Mental health professional
- PT, OT, ST

- Certified genetic counselor
- **Podiatrist**

Patient-provider relationship can be established via telemedicine

## **TELEDENTISTRY**

Minnesota Medicaid offers reimbursement parity and requires prior authorization for consultations by out of state providers.

## MENTAL HEALTH

Medicaid-covered mental health services can be delivered via telehealth and via **audio-only** telehealth until July 1, 2024.

## **AUDIO-ONLY**

Until July 1, 2024, insurers must provide coverage for audio-only telehealth services.

**E-VISITS:** Nothing in private payer or Medicaid rules
